

AUTOCAD Level 1 & 2 – Virtual Class Requirements/Information:

Important Note: Sheridan courses are AutoCAD for Windows (**not Mac**).

Each of the AutoCAD courses have 10 live/virtual synchronous class sessions; 2 evenings per week for 5 weeks/3 hours each session; 6 hours/week. Sessions may be recorded should you miss a session. The instructor will provide further details at the first session.

Mandatory Requirements for attending the virtual/online course:

- Reliable Broadband internet connection
- Administrator permissions to install applications (AutoCAD and the virtual training application)
- Install AutoCAD 2023 before the first session (details below)-Autodesk software is free for Sheridan students

System Requirements:

Students should use the latest version of AutoCAD i.e., 2023. However, if you have downloaded or used either 2022 or 2021 version that will also work for this course. Autodesk student versions are free and can be downloaded from the Autodesk website directly. Students will receive instructions on how to download the software upon enrollment.

Students will need to review the AutoCAD System Requirements (here you will find the latest version system requirements for 2023)

Optional:

- For computer audio: Headset is recommended for microphone and speakers but not required. You can also use built-in microphone and speakers or external speakers.
- For phone audio: you can also join the training session audio by dialing the session number and the access code from your phone
- Second Monitor: one monitor to use AutoCAD and the other one to follow the step-by-step trainer instructions.

Notes: If you do not have two monitors, you can join the session as two users (one from your computer/laptop and the other from another computer, tablet, or smartphone to watch the trainer instructions).
