AUTOCAD Level 1 & Level 2 – Virtual Class Requirements/Information:

Important Note: These courses are for Windows only (they are not suitable for Mac users)

AutoCAD courses have 10 live/virtual class sessions; 2 evenings per week for 5 weeks; 3 hours each session; 6 hours per week. Sessions will be recorded should you miss a class. The instructor will provide further details at the first session.
